

How to Get to KBU from KANSAI Airport (KIX)

The most practical means of getting to Kyoto is by train. The JR West Haruka limited expresses run from the airport to Kyoto (73 min). Trains run every 30 minutes. The Kintetsu railway runs between Kyoto station and Mukaijima station. It takes about 20 minutes to Mukaijima station. And then you take our school bus after getting off at Mukaijima station. You can get to KBU after a 5-minute ride on the bus.

Uji and Kyoto

Uji City is located to the south of Kyoto City. Uji City is centrally located on the beautiful Uji River, and is graced with old temples and shrines with its own beauty and atmosphere, indicative of Uji City`s long history and rich culture.
